Wind conditions in Northern Europe were generally below average in March 2010. In March, the production figures from the Energia Verde project in Italy outperformed expectations.

Projects under construction

Monte Grighine (50%) 98.9 MW

Thirty-two turbines have been connected to the grid. The work of connecting the remaining 11 turbines continues, and as previously announced, this work is expected to be finalised before the end of May. All 43 turbines have now been installed, as blades have been mounted on the last turbine.

Minerva Messina (85%) 48.3 MW

Six turbines have been connected to the grid. The remaining 15 turbines are expected to be connected during the period until the end of May. The work involving the transformer station continues according to plan. According to the present timetable, Terna should be able to commence testing of the transformer station at the beginning of May.

Projects under development

No significant events occurred during the month of March 2010.

Other matters

Greentech has decided to test prices and conditions in the market with a view to a potential sale of wind farms in operation. Once this process has been completed, the Company will decide whether it would be expedient to divest specific wind farms in operation.
